## The Briefing Process

Firstly, thank you so much for choosing to charter a bareboat with Fraser Island Boat Charters! Now that we've confirmed your booking we can example exactly what you'll expect when you arriving including our briefing process.

Once you arrive at the Great Sandy Straits Marina, we'll greet you and let you familiarise yourself with the yacht you'll be staying on board.

Our commercially qualified skipper will then run you through a very detailed briefing session that could run up to 4 hours. The idea of this session is to run you through anything you could need to know about operating the vessel, where to go and how to anchor. Once our skipper knows everyone is comfortable, he will drive the yacht out of the marina and leave you to sail into the sunset!
